Deuteronomy 30:6 | The Lord your God will circumcise your hearts and the hearts of your descendants, so that you may love him with all your heart and with all your soul, and live.

Psalm 91:9-11 | If you say, "The Lord is my refuge," and you make the Most High your dwelling, no harm will overtake you, no disaster will come near your tent. For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways;

I thank you Lord that our children make you, the Most High, ONLY wise God, their place of dwelling and their refuge, therefore no disaster will come near them for You command your angels to guard them.

### Psalm 115:14 | May the Lord cause you to flourish, both you and your children.

Psalm 121:5-6 | The Lord watches over you, the Lord is your shade at your right hand; the sun will not harm you by day, nor the moon by night.

Proverbs 23:24 | The father of a righteous child has great joy; a man who fathers a wise son rejoices in him.

Father, I thank You we have great joy because our children have become the righteousness of God through Christ, Jesus and walk in wisdom.

Isaiah 44:3 | For I will pour water on the thirsty land, and streams on the dry ground; I will pour out my Spirit on your offspring, and my blessing on your descendants.

I thank You Father our children are filled with your Holy Spirit, and are happy, favored, to be envied, because you have poured out your Spirit and blessings upon our children and our children's children

Isaiah 49:25 | But this is what the Lord says: Yes, captives will be taken from warriors, and plunder retrieved from the fierce; I will contend with those who contend with you, and your children I will save. God will save my offspring from all captivity; they shall return, have rest and be at ease in the Lord. No one shall make them afraid.



Father, according to Your word, I pray our children are rescued from the snares the enemy has laid for them. Isaiah 54:13 | All your children will be taught by the Lord, and great will be their peace. In righteousness you will be established: Tyranny will be far from you; you will have nothing to fear. Terror will be far removed; it will not come near you. If anyone does attack you, it will not be my doing; whoever attacks you will surrender to you.

I thank you Lord that our children are taught of you and great is their peace.

Jeremiah 30:10 | "'So do not be afraid, Jacob my servant; do not be dismayed, Israel,' declares the Lord. 'I will surely save you out of a distant place, your descendants from the land of their exile. Jacob will again have peace and security, and no one will make him afraid.

I pray over our children, according to Your word, they are rescued out of the world, anxiety, depression, and insecurity, and have been brought to the Kingdom of God where they abide in peace, joy, and security

1 Corinthians 1:4-9 | I always thank my God for you because of his grace given you in Christ Jesus. For in him you have been enriched in every way—with all kinds of speech and with all knowledge — God thus confirming our testimony about Christ among you. Therefore you do not lack any spiritual gift as you eagerly wait for our Lord Jesus Christ to be revealed. He will also keep you firm to the end, so that you will be blameless on the day of our Lord Jesus Christ. God is faithful, who has called you into fellowship with his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

Father, I thank you for the unmerited favor you've given us in Christ Jesus. I pray, according to your word, our children have been called into fellowship with You; and in Christ our children are enriched, enhanced, fortified in every way, and that you confirm for them the testimony about Christ. I thank You they do not lack any spiritual gift, they are made blameless through the blood of Jesus Christ and kept by You so that they remain blameless until Jesus comes back.

1 Corinthians 6:18-19 | Flee from sexual immorality. All other sins a person commits are outside the body, but whoever sins sexually, sins against their own body. 19 Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own;

Thank you Father, our children flee from all sexual immorality and impurity in thought, word, or

deed, and they realize their body is the temple of the Holy Spirit.

Ephesians 6:2-3 | Honor your father and mother"—which is the first commandment with a promise— 3 "so that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth."

Our children honor their parents, so it will be will with them and they will live long on the earth.



Romans 12:2 | Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.

Thank you Lord, our children are not conformed to this world's system. They do not agree with what this world says is right but are anchored in the word of God. They are transformed by the renewing of their minds, their minds have been washed by the Word of God and now they align their thoughts with Yours. They are intimately acquainted with and perform what is the good, acceptable, and perfect will of God for their lives.

Ephesians 1:17-18 | I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better. I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people,

God, I pray our children develop a love and hunger for You and are sensitive to your voice. They are hungry for the things of the Spirit. Revelation from God flows to them – they see and understand spiritual things. They know what God has called them to do, and they want to do it!

Ephesians 3:14-21 | For this reason, I kneel before the Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.

Father, I pray, in agreement with your word, that our children are strengthened with power through Your spirit in their inner being and Christ dwells in their hearts through faith. I pray they are rooted and established in love and have the ability to understand how wide, long, high, and deep is love of the Christ and this love will be known by their hearts rather than just their heads. Thank you they are each filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.



Ephesians 5:1-2 Follow God's example, therefore, as dearly loved children and walk in the way of love, just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.

Our family walks in love. My relationship with our children is blessed; we walk in love with each other and enjoy each other as God intended. Love is free to reign in our family. We don't allow strife or division, but pray that our family is filled with peace and harmony. Give us wisdom, Father, to bless and help each other.

Father, I pray, in agreement with your word, that my children are filled with the knowledge of Your will through the wisdom and understanding the Spirit gives. Because of this, our children live a life worthy of you and please you in every way. I pray our children no longer perform deeds of darkness. Our children bear fruit in every good work, grow in the knowledge of God and are strengthened with all power according to Your glorious might. I thank you they are joyful in thanking You. Colossians 3:15 | Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful.

Peace reigns in the heart and mind of our children. God's peace upon them in every sense of the word – wholeness, completeness, nothing lacking, nothing lost. That peace guides them and keeps them. Our children have great peace in their lives.

2 Timothy 1:7 | For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline.
